

To access the new online Academic Misconduct Forms, please follow these steps:


Step 1: Visit <u>integrity.fiu.edu</u>




Step 2: Locate the 'Online Forms' subheading at the bottom-right side of the webpage.




Step 3: Click 'Informal Resolution Form'



Step 4: A new window will appear. Login using your MyAccounts username and password.




Step 5: Enter the student's Panther ID (PID) and click 'search' to look up whether the student has had a previous academic misconduct.




Step 6: If the student *does not* have a previous academic misconduct, you may proceed with the informal resolution process and will be directed to the Informal Resolution Form. Complete the form in the presence of the student and your supervisor or appointee.

Note: If your course is online or if your supervisor or the student is unavailable to meet, you can conduct this meeting via phone or web conference.



Step 7: If the student *does* have a previous academic misconduct, you must proceed with the formal resolution process and therefore, will be unable to access the Informal Resolution Form. Please contact Dr. Valerie George (FIU's Faculty Fellow for Academic Integrity) for further details.
